2019 Lake Capote Ice Fishing Contest Rules

1. Everyone must register at the bait shop upon arrival.
2. All contestants will receive a wrist band which must be worn for the duration of the contest.
3. The contest will start at 9:00am and end at 3:00pm. An air horn will be blown indicating when to start and stop. No one can start fishing until the start signal is sounded. At 3:00pm when the horn sounds, everyone must stop fishing.
4. One fishing rod limit per contestant.
5. No live bait except for worms and night crawlers will be allowed.
6. Fish will be weighed in pounds /oz.
7. Only live fish will be weighed. Contestants are responsible for keeping their fish alive until they are weighed in.
8. Fish may be weighed anytime during the day, but all fish must be weighed in before 3:00pm.
9. There is not a limit on how many fish can be checked in, but there is a limit on what you can keep (please see proclamation for bag/possession limits).
10. There will be two categories (by weight); Largest Fish Overall, and Largest Fish by Species (Trout, Bass, Catfish).
11. Contestants must be present to win. If a contestant is not present, the prize will be awarded to the fisherman with the next largest fish.
12. Any disputes among fishermen will be decided by an official. The official's decisions are final.
13. In the event of a tie, the fish that was weighed in first will be declared the winner.
14. The official time clock will be located at the bait shop.
15. Only registered anglers may fish during the contest, any contestant fishing with an unregistered angler will be disqualified.
16. All equipment must be removed from the bank prior to leaving for the day.
17. All registration fees are non-refundable.
18. By signing the registration, you are giving the event producers permission to use competitor photos for marketing purposes.
19. The Southern Ute Indian Tribe does not claim responsibility for personal belongings, accidents or injuries on or off the ice.
20. By entering the 2019 Capote Lake Ice Fishing Contest and signing the registration you agree to comply with, but not limited to all contest rules and regulations. Any violation of these rules will result in disqualification.

Agreement for Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Release of Liability, and Indemnification

In consideration of participating in ice fishing ("Fishing") at the Lake Capote Recreation Area ("Lake"), I acknowledge and agree as follows:

- 1. Assumption of risk.** There are inherent dangers associated with the activities of Fishing and these dangers may be increased when the participants are minors. I understand and acknowledge that such risks cannot be eliminated nor does the Lake or the Southern Ute Indian Tribe ("Tribe") have the duty, responsibility or ability to eliminate such risks due to the nature of such activities. I knowingly assume all such risks of injury or death, whether identified in the attached Appendices or not, that may result from my and/or my child's participation in Fishing and I assume full responsibility for my child's and my own participation.
- 2. Program Independent Contractor/Volunteers.** I understand and acknowledge that the Tribe may hire an Independent Contractor(s) or utilize volunteers to operate and direct Fishing. The Lake and the Tribe therefore may or may not exercise direct control or supervision over Fishing and therefore have no duty of care toward me or my child as a participant in this activity or to protect me or my child from injuries or harms arising from the actions or negligence of the Independent Contractor or a volunteer. I understand and acknowledge that the Tribe or Lake may sponsor or provide a venue for Fishing, but that this sponsorship and/or venue do not give the Tribe or Lake any control over the provision of services from any Independent Contractor or a volunteer.
- 3. Waiver and release of liability.** For myself, my child participating in Fishing, and my heirs, I hereby waive and release the Tribe, its Tribal Council members, appointed officials, employees, and agents and the Lake and its employees (collectively "released parties") from all claims, liabilities, causes of action, and damages that in any way arise out of, are connected with, or result from me or my child's participation in Fishing.
- 4. Agreement to pay costs and attorney fees.** For myself, my child if participating in Fishing, and my heirs, I agree that if I make any claim or bring any suit against the released parties, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover reasonable attorney's fees and costs.
- 5. Indemnification.** I agree to defend and indemnify the released parties for any loss or damage that results from claims or lawsuits for personal injury, death and/or property loss or damage related in any way to my or my child's participation in Fishing in any capacity whatsoever.
- 6. Governing law, forum, and non-waiver of immunity.** The forum for the resolution of any dispute arising from this agreement shall be the Southern Ute Indian Tribal Court and the governing law shall be tribal law. Nothing in this agreement, however, shall constitute a waiver of any immunity of the Tribe or the Lake.

In addition to the terms of the agreement set forth above, therefore, I agree that it is my duty and responsibility, as either a parent or guardian, or as the adult in whose care the participant has been entrusted, to provide supervision in an effort to protect the participant from harm associated with participation in Fishing. By signing below, I am (1) entering into this agreement on my own behalf and on behalf of the participant, (2) representing, if I am an adult in whose care the participant has been entrusted, that I have the authority to sign this document on behalf of the participant, and (3) agreeing to be bound by the terms of this agreement.
